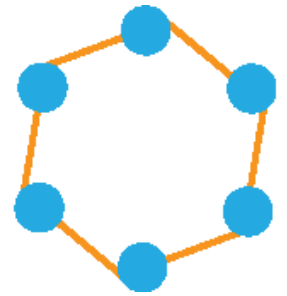


MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM MDT RESPONSE TO CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE INVESTIGATIONS
